In 1939, as Europe goes to war, young Alma Belasco's parents send her to live in safety with an aunt and uncle in their opulent San Francisco mansion. There, she meets Ichimei Fukunda, the son of the family's Japanese gardener, and between them, a tender love blossoms – but it is a love they are forever forced to hide.

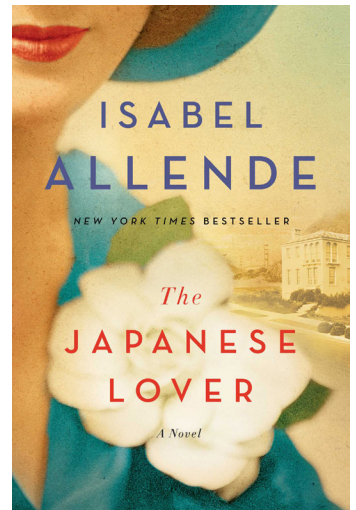
